Anyone with visiting student status is not eligible.

# Eligibility criteria

- Current student at Université Laval
- Currently in a precarious financial situation
- Unable to further reduce expenses or increase income
- Budget deficit
- No longer able to meet basic needs
- Studies compromised by the precarious financial situation

### Comments

- Your student financial assistance file from the Ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur may be checked, and additional documents may be requested in order to fully understand your situation.
