Objective

Promote the pursuit of university studies and support students who are experiencing financial difficulties

Eligibility criteria

- [Be in a precarious financial situation](#) (you must complete the budget analysis on the electronic form)
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or foreign student
- Have successfully completed one semester at Université Laval (12 credits) and have paid the tuition fees
- Be enrolled full time ([or be deemed full time according to MEES](#)) at Université Laval for the current semester
- Have a minimum program average of 2.00 out of 4.33 for undergraduates and 2.67 out of 4.33 for graduate students
- Simultaneously combine studies and work during the current year. Social involvement could also be considered according to the situation
- Have submitted a financial aid application (loans and bursaries) to the government of your Canadian province. This obligation applies to all student having the Canadian citizenship, or the permanent resident or refugee status.



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Please note that **students benefitting from an official exchange program are not eligible for this bursary.**

Important: Write a paragraph of approximately 15 lines in the appropriate section of the electronic form explaining the reasons for your financial difficulties (e.g., work/study/family balance; family or health situation; left home to study, etc.) as well as the steps you have taken (job, government financial aid, academic scholarship, bank loan, assistance from a family member or friend, etc.) to date to try to improve your financial situation.

Please note that one of the eligibility requirements is to satisfactorily demonstrate that the bursary is essential to the pursuit of your studies and that your financial difficulties are exceptional.

Comments

Students may not receive emergency financial aid more than once per year (from May 1st to April 30th). Applications will be reviewed on a monthly basis. All students who have submitted an application will receive a response within one month.

Note: Unless requested otherwise, the names of bursary recipients may be forwarded to the donor as well as to certain institutional bodies for administrative purposes (advertising, selection committees, bursary award ceremonies, statistics, etc.).
