### Objective

Promote the pursuit of university studies and support students who are experiencing financial difficulties

### Amount

Several bursaries up to \$1,500

### Frequency

Offered every year

### Reserved for

- Canadian citizens
- Permanent residents
- Foreign students

### Target clientele

- Undergraduate students (All programs and faculties)
- Master's students (All programs and faculties)
- Doctoral students (All programs and faculties)

Please note that **students benefitting from an official exchange program are not eligible for this bursary.**

### Eligibility criteria

- Be in a [precarious financial situation](#)
- Be enrolled full time ([or be deemed full time according to MEES](#)) at Université Laval for the current semester
- Have successfully completed 12 credits at Université Laval and have paid the tuition fees
- Have a minimum program average of 2.00 out of 4.33 for undergraduates and 2.67 out of 4.33 for graduate students
- Simultaneously combine studies and work during the current year. Social involvement could also be considered according to the situation
- Have submitted a financial aid application (loans and bursaries) to the government of your Canadian province. This obligation applies to all student having the Canadian citizenship, or the permanent resident or refugee status.

## **Comments**

Please note that one of the eligibility requirements is to satisfactorily demonstrate that the bursary is essential to the pursuit of your studies and that your financial difficulties are exceptional.

## **Submitting your application**

The form is submitted electronically.

Students may not receive emergency financial aid more than once per year (from May 1<sup>st</sup> to April 30<sup>th</sup>). Applications will be reviewed on a monthly basis. All students who have submitted an application will receive a response within one month.

Note that the selection committee may check in your MEES student financial assistance file and additional documents may be required to determine your financial situation.
