Objective

These scholarships are offered by Ministère de l'Éducation et de l'Enseignement supérieur (MEES) to foster international research activities in Québec universities, attract the best international students, and promote Québec universities abroad.

Amount

- Multiple \$25,000 scholarships (The scholarship amount is \$25,000 per year, for a period of up to three years (nine semesters), with the option of an extension for up to 12 additional months. In addition to the scholarship, MEES will waive the supplemental tuition fees applicable to international students and offer government-sponsored health insurance for all recipients of scholarships through this program.)

Eligibility criteria

In addition to the eligibility criteria listed on the [FRQNT website](#), Université Laval has the following requirements:

- **Minimum GPA of 4/4.33*** for the last master's degree program, completed or not. *A certification clearly stating the program GPA from the issuing institution will be required in addition to your transcripts;*
- Applicants must already be registered **or have applied** to a doctoral program at Université Laval when applying for the scholarship;

- Students must have **at least two (2) scientific articles accepted by or published in a peer-reviewed journal**. For students in a research-creation program, artistic achievements will be also considered.

REFEREE: You must enter the name of someone who will serve as your referee in the designated section of the form. To ensure confidentiality, your referee will automatically receive a secure link to complete their section online. Please make sure you enter their email address correctly in the designated field.

Your referee will also need to submit their recommendation before the deadline. It is your responsibility to make sure your referee has received the email and submitted their recommendation by the deadline. Applications that do not include a recommendation by the deadline will be rejected. You will receive an automatic email notification when your referee submits their form and your application is considered complete.
