Objective

Financially support students with a **current budget deficit** preventing them from meeting their **basic needs** and for whom the pursuit of studies may be compromised.

- Canadian citizens
- Permanent residents
- Foreign students

Target clientele

Undergraduate

- Agriculture and Food Sciences
 - o All bachelor's degrees

Master's level

- Agriculture and Food Sciences
 - o All master's degrees

Doctoral level

- Agriculture and Food Sciences
 - o All PhDs

Students taking short programs, certificates, and advanced graduate diplomas, as well as qualifying coursework and non-degree studies, are also eligible.

Please note that students benefitting from an official exchange program are not eligible for this bursary.

Eligibility criteria

- Be in a precarious financial situation
- Be enrolled full time (or be deemed full-time) at Université Laval for the current semester *
- Have successfully completed 12 credits at Université Laval and have paid the tuition fees
- Have a minimum program average of 2.00 out of 4.33 for undergraduates and 2.67 out of 4.33 for graduate students

- Have submitted a financial aid application (loans and bursaries) to the government of your Canadian province. This obligation applies to all student having the Canadian citizenship, or the permanent resident or refugee status.
- * A student registered part-time in the last semester of his study program is eligible.
- ** If you do not meet the eligibility criteria and you are in a precarious financial situation, you can make an appointment by email to be accompanied in your search for solutions.

Comments

- The review committee may check your MEES student financial aid file and you may be asked to supply additional proof of your financial situation.
- Please note that, at the request of the donors, some bursaries have additional criteria attached.
- We invite you to consult the My finances section. There you will find tools to help you improve your financial health.

Please note that the recipients must be present at the FSAA scholarships ceremony to be held in the winter session 2022.

Submitting your application

- You must complete the online form.
- Students cannot apply more than once in a single semester.
- A reply will be sent to your monPortail account and emailed to your @ulaval.ca email address.
- If you have the status of "deemed full-time" as a student parent, you will need to download the certificate from the
 Registrar's Office in the appropriate section of the form. Note that a delay of 7 working days is expected to obtain this
 document.
