- Study here in Canada and hold a valid study permit.*

^{*}Students without a study permit: Due to the pandemic situation, Université Laval had granted certain accommodation measures by allowing distance studies. Note that since the summer 2022 semester, students must be studying in Canada and have a valid study permit to be eligible for their scholarship payments.
