You may be asked for budget support with a socio-economic resources advisor from the BBAF for the analysis of your file.

### Objective

Promote the pursuit of university studies and support students of the Faculty of Forestry, Geography and Geomatics with a current budget deficit preventing them from meeting their basic needs and for whom the pursuit of studies may be compromised.

Students taking short programs, certificates, and advanced graduate diplomas, as well as qualifying coursework and non-degree studies, are also eligible.

Students benefitting from an official exchange program are not eligible for this bursary.

### Eligibility criteria

If you meet the eligibility criteria below, please submit your application.

If you do not meet the eligibility criteria and you are in a precarious financial situation, you can make an appointment by email to be accompanied in your search for solutions.

- Be in a precarious financial situation
- Be registered as a full-time student (or <u>Full-time Student Status at l'Aide financière aux études</u>) at Université Laval in an admissible program\*
- Have successfully completed 12 credits at Université Laval and have paid the tuition fees
- Have a minimum program average of 2.00 out of 4.33 for undergraduates and 2.67 out of 4.33 for graduate students
- Have submitted a financial aid application (loans and bursaries) to the government of your Canadian province. This
  obligation applies to all student having the Canadian citizenship, or the permanent resident or refugee status.
- \* Part-time students (6 to 11 credits): If you are considered as a parent student according to the terms and conditions of the Politique relative aux étudiantes et aux étudiants parents de l'Université Laval, you could be eligible for this contest. To do so, it is your responsibility to submit the Attestation delivered by the Registrar Office by uploading it in the appropriate section of the online form. Please note that a seven (7) business day period is needed to process the document.
- \* A student registered part-time in the last semester of his study program is eligible.

## Comments

- The review committee may check your MEES student financial aid file and you may be asked to supply additional proof of your financial situation.
- Please note that, at the request of the donors, some bursaries have additional criteria attached.
- We invite you to consult the My finances section. There you will find tools to help you improve your financial health.

## Submitting your application

- Students cannot apply more than once in a single semester.
- A reply will be sent to your monPortail account and emailed to your @ulaval.ca email address.
