Québec's Ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur (MES) offers scholarships for doctoral studies, a postdoctoral fellowship, or short-term research or professional development. The scholarship program is administered by Fonds québécois de la recherche sur la nature et les technologies (FRQNT).

Instructions and preselection form

Université Laval can only recommend four (4) applicants per year for this category in addition to the quota by citizenship for specific countries. Only applicants preselected by the University will be invited by FRQNT to apply.

Application for preselection must be supported by a professor who agrees to receive the student and supervise his/her research.

IMPORTANT DATES

June 17, 2024:	Deadline for applicants to submit applications for preselection by the university
September 30, 2024:	Deadline for the university to submit the preselected list of applicants to FRQNT
November 1, 2024:	Deadline for the university to submit scholarship applications from preselected applicants to FRQNT

Eligibility requirements

This program is open to applicants who are neither Canadian citizens nor permanent residents of Canada. Before completing an application for preselection, applicants must ensure they are eligible for the Merit Scholarship Program for Foreign Students by consulting the program guidelines, on the FRQNT website:

Required documents

The following documents are required for preselection by the university:

1. The duly completed and signed **preselection form**.
2. A PDF version of a [Canadian Common CV \(CCV\)](#) Vanier-Banting
3. A **presentation**, maximum 2 pages, **of the short research or skills upgrading project** in which you must:
 - Describe the short research or skills upgrading project (if the internship must be done in more than one stage, the different stages must be specified).
 - Describe the objectives of the short research or skills upgrading project and their relevance to the study program.
 - Describe the nature and role of the scientific supervision during the short research or skills upgrading project.
 - Describe a schedule of the main steps of the short research or skills upgrading project.
 - Describe your path since obtaining your last diploma.
 - Describe the potential contribution of advancing knowledge.
4. A **presentation of your background**: You must present your background in an integrated way by establishing the links between your experiences and interests, on the one hand, and your choices of orientation, training and academic path, on the other. This section should allow the evaluation committee to fully understand your background. A document in PDF format of 1 page is allowed.
5. A **letter of acceptance from the research supervisor**.
6. Two (2) **letters of recommendation** (Please send letters from one to two pages on letterhead paper. The FRQNT form for the letter of reference will be required only if the candidate is preselected).
7. **Academic transcripts (French or English)** for all university studies undertaken (certificates, diplomas, Bachelor's, Master's or PhD programs, etc.) **in chronological order, starting with the most recent**, whether completed or not. (For academic transcripts from institutions outside of North America, applicants must attach a letter explaining the grading system in effect at the institution in question).
8. **Photocopy** of the identification page of a valid **passport** from the applicant's country of origin or any official documents establishing the applicant's citizenship.
9. **If necessary**, add a comment (page 2 of the form) for any situation that may have an impact on the evaluation of your file (cultural background, special circumstances, interruption in your academic background, etc.)



All documents submitted in a language other than French or English must be accompanied by a certified translation.

Validation of eligibility criteria

- You are a foreign student (Cannot have applied for permanent resident status under Canadian immigration law as of Nov. 1, 2024)
- You are currently studying in a bachelor, master or doctoral program (option A) or you have completed a doctorate no more than five years before the deadline for the competition (Nov. 1, 2024) (option B).
- Your short-term research or professional development will be conducted in an institution other than the one at which you are enrolled when you apply.
- You have not already received a Merit Scholarship for Foreign Students from MEES, FRQNT or the Fonds de recherche du Québec – Société et culture (FRQSC);
