Who it's for

- Doctoral level
 - All Masters Research Programs (Professional Master's Programs are not eligible)

Eligibility criteria

Candidates are eligible for master's research scholarships for the first six semesters of their master's studies. To apply, candidates must have been enrolled in a master's program for up to three full-time semesters (1 year) or less before May 1, 2025. All semesters made in another master program are included in the total number of semesters.

In addition to the eligibility criteria listed on the <u>FRQNT website</u>, Université Laval has the following requirements:

- Minimum GPA of 4/4.33* for the last Bachelor's degree program, completed or not.
- Applicants must already be registered or have accepted an offer of admission in a master program at University Laval when applying for the scholarship or be already registered to Laval University;

A delay of 48 to 72 hours might be necessary before you can connect. We suggest that you submit your application for a doctoral program before June 10, 2024 to avoid technical problems.
