## Objective

The Government of Canada launched the Vanier Canada Graduate to strengthen Canada's ability to attract and retain world-class doctoral students and establish Canada as a global centre of excellence in research and higher learning.

## Amount

- Multiple 50 000 \$ scholarships (The scholarship amount is 50 000\$ per year, for a period of up to three years.)

## Frequency

Offered every year

## Eligible applicants

- Canadian citizens
- Permanent residents of Canada
- International students

## Who it's for

- **Doctoral level**
  - All PhDs

A committee of internal experts at Université Laval will review the applications and determine which ones are worthy of recognition. The program administrator will then recommend those selected through ResearchNet. All students who submit their applications for internal review by the deadline will receive a reply around mid-October, after the committee of experts has made their assessment.

## Comments

### **Reminder – Self-Identified Indigenous applicants :**

Institutions may recommend applications from self-identified Indigenous (First Nations, Inuit, and/or Métis) to the Vanier CGS competition above and beyond their institutional quota. Indigenous applicants must agree to their personal information being used for this purpose by making the appropriate selection in the application form by attaching the Vanier Canada Graduate Scholarship (Vanier CGS): Voluntary Self-Identification Form to their application in ResearchNet.

For those who choose to self-identify as Indigenous (First Nations, Inuit, and/or Métis) they have been instructed to complete the [Vanier Canada Graduate Scholarship \(Vanier CGS\): Voluntary Self-Identification Form \[ PDF \(409 KB\) \]](#) for Indigenous (First Nations, Inuit and/or Métis) Applicants and upload it within their application. This form may be used by Research Administrators to identify self-declared Indigenous applicants.

\* Important : Students who include foreign transcripts, must attach a 250-word summary/grading scale in a PDF document to the beginning of the transcripts, describing any variations in the grading system between the foreign institutions and the Canadian-level equivalents, and/or explaining international credentials and equivalencies. If the international transcripts are not presented in one of Canada's two official languages (English or French), include a certified translation, separated from the original transcripts by a blank page.
