



## MOLSON FOUNDATION FRENCH IMMERSION SCHOLARSHIP

### Objective

Reward English-speaking students who wish to undertake undergraduate or graduate studies at Université Laval.

### Amount

Several scholarships of varying amounts (\$ 5,000 for a one-year study program and \$ 10,000 for a degree study program (payable in two years).

### Frequency

Offered every year

### Reserved for

- Canadian citizens
- Permanent residents

### Target clientele

#### Undergraduate

- All bachelor's degrees

#### Master's level

- All master's degrees

#### Doctoral level

- All PhDs

Certificates and Advanced studies diploma are also eligible.

Visiting students and students admitted to the program for French in minority communities are not eligible.

### Eligibility criteria

- Being an English-speaking person.
- Having his permanent address outside the province of Quebec at the time of filing the application.
- Being a non-resident of Quebec (not having been born in Quebec, and not having the Quebec resident status).
- Starting studies at Université Laval in fall 2025 semester in an admissible program.
- Being enrolled full time\* (or « [deemed full time](#) »).

\* **Part-time students** (6 to 11 credits): If you are considered as a **parent student** according to the terms and conditions of the [Politique relative aux étudiantes et aux étudiants parents de l'Université Laval](#), you could be eligible for this contest. To do so, it is your responsibility to submit the [Attestation delivered by the Registrar Office](#) by emailing it to: [info@bbaf.ulaval.ca](mailto:info@bbaf.ulaval.ca), and to mention which specific program it is for. Please note that a seven (7) business day period is needed to process the document.

### Selection criteria

- Academic performance
- Priority given to undergraduate candidates

### Comments

- If your residency or citizenship has not been recognized by the Bureau du registraire, but the process is in progress, please advise us.
- Studies fully undertaken by distance learning are not eligible.
- 5 000\$ scholarships (one year programs) will be payable in two equal payments: the first one in fall semester and the second one in winter semester.
- 10 000\$ scholarships (undergraduate & graduate programs) will be payable in four equal payments, over 2 years (fall and winter semesters).
- A student who's Elementary school was in French or whose first language is French is not eligible.
- According to the donor's wishes, priority will be given to undergraduate candidates.
- These scholarships are not renewable.
- An undergraduate recipient can not apply again at a graduate level.
- At the time of the scholarship offer, the candidate must have received from the Université Laval a **conditional or final offer of admission** in an eligible program. Applicants on the waiting list will not be accepted.

### Submitting your application

You must complete the online form.

#### In the appropriate online form section you'll need to:

- Upload a copy of your most recent transcript that must include all the results of the diploma obtained (your documents may be in French or in English).
- Upload a copy of your Elementary school transcript.
