Objective

These scholarships are offered by Ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur (MES) to foster international research activities in Québec universities, attract the best international students, and promote Québec universities abroad.

Amount

• Multiple \$25,000 scholarships (The scholarship amount is \$25,000 per year, for a period of up to three years (nine semesters), with the option of an extension for up to 12 additional months. In addition to the scholarship, MEES will waive the supplemental tuition fees applicable to international students and offer government-sponsored health insurance for all recipients of scholarships through this program.).

Eligibility criteria

IMPORTANT: To apply, applicants must have been enrolled in a doctoral program for a maximum of nine full-time semesters or fewer before May 1, 2026 (all doctoral programs combined). All doctoral semesters completed before the scholarship becomes effective (corresponding to the first payment), whether funded or not, are deducted from the eligibility period.

Candidates admitted to the doctoral program after undergraduate studies, and those who are fast-tracking to the doctoral program without having submitted a dissertation, must apply for the doctoral competition to obtain a scholarship during their third, fourth, and fifth years of graduate studies (between the seventh and fifteenth semesters). In this case, applicants may first apply for a Master's scholarship (VM) to obtain a scholarship during the first six graduate semesters (the student must have submitted an application for admission to the doctoral program or be a Université Laval student to be eligible).

In addition to the eligibility criteria listed on the <u>FRQNT website</u>, Université Laval has the following requirements:

- Minimum GPA of 4/4.33* for the last master's degree program, completed or not. A certification clearly stating the program GPA from the issuing institution will be required in addition to your transcripts;
- Applicants must already be registered **or or must have submitted an application for admission in** a doctoral program at University Laval when applying for the scholarship;
- Students must have at least two (2) scientific articles accepted by or published in a peerreviewed journal. For students in a research-creation program, your application file must contain at least two (2) artistic achievements (e.g. recitals, novel, concert, etc.)

Any document submitted in a language other than French or English must be accompanied by a certified translation. Please consult the list of <u>Required Documents</u> before submitting your application.

IDENTIFICATION/SUBMISSION: In order to submit your application you must authenticate your identity using the personal identification information sent to you by the UL Registrar's Office when creating your admission package. A delay of 48 to 72 hours might be necessary before you can connect. We suggest that you submit your application for a doctoral program before June 9, 2025 to avoid technical problems.
